Subject: Enhancement in 'Malba Fee', prescribing the area and period for stacking building material on municipal roads/streets.

In pursuance of the decision taken in the review meeting of Municipal Corporations held on 16.7.1999 under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary, Local Government, Punjab, the matter referred to in the subject has been considered at Government level with the intention to organize removal of Malba from Municipal roads/streets in a sustained and systematic manner. To rationalize the rates of Malba fee and use of municipal roads/streets for stacking Building Materials, the following rates, maximum period and the portion of road/street, which can be used for stacking building material may be adopted under intimation to Government:-
